
Throw Quilt Assembly

- Follow the same instructions for Purple Flower petals as the Full guilt
- Sew 2 of the petals together with the 2 x 16 1/2" Green strips between them
- Repeat for 2 Half flowers
- Sew 2 2 x 16 1/2" Green strips together with 1 2" White square between them
- Sew the two flower sections together with the 2 x 34" Green/White sashing strip between them
- Sew 1 2 x 34" White strip to each side of the flower
- Sew 1 2 x 37" White strip to the top and bottom of the flower
- Mark the center of bot the flower and the 24 1/2" White triangles (along the longest edge) and sew one to each side, matching centers
- · Trim as needed to square up quilt
- Add Green Border #1, then White Border #2, then Green Border #3
- · Add back, quilt, and bind



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King Sized Quilt

Approximately 109 x 109"

King Fabric Requirements

White - 7 1/3 yards

Dark Red - 1 1/4 yards

Light Red - 3/4 yard

Dark Purple - 1 1/4 yards

Light Purple - 3/4 yard

Yellow - 3/8 yard

Green - 1 1/2 yards

Binding - 3/4 yard

Back - 9 3/4 yards

King Cutting Instructions

White

Cut one 74" piece (Fig A)

Along the length of fabric cut:

- 2 1 1/2 x 71 1/2" strips
- 1 2 x 69" strip
- 2 1 1/2 x 68 1/2" strips
- 2 2 x 34" strips

From rest of this piece:

- Cut 3 4 1/2" strips WOF, subcut into
 - 16 4 1/2" squares
 - 4 2" squares
 - 1 4 1/2 x 8" strip, from strip cut 2 Template C
- Cut 6 8 1/2" strips WOF, subcut into
 - 16 8 1/2 x 9 1/4" strips, from strips cut 32 Template B and 32 Template F
 - 4 4 1/2 x 8" strips, from strips cut 8 Template C

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- Cut 1 4 1/2" strip WOF
- Subcut 6 4 1/2 x 8" strips, from strips cut 12 Template C From Remaining White fabric (not shown):
- Cut 1 4 1/2" strip WOF
 - Subcut 5 4 1/2 x 8" strips, from strips cut 10 Template C
- Cut 4 36" squares
 - · Cut each in half on the diagonal
- Cut 11 3 1/2" strips, sew these together to make:
 - 2 3 1/2 x 107 1/2" Top/Bottom Border #2 strips
 - 2 3 1/2 x 101 1/2" Side Border #2 strips



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Dark Red

- Cut 8 8 1/2" squares
- Cut 8 Large Petals from Template A
- Cut 8 from template D

Light Red

- · Cut 8 Large Petals from Template A
- Cut 8 from template D

Dark Purple

- Cut 8 8 1/2" squares
- Cut 8 Large Petals from Template A
- · Cut 8 from template D

Light Purple

- Cut 8 Large Petals from Template A
- Cut 8 from template D

Yellow

- Cut 32 2 1/2" squares
- Cut 32 Small Petals from Template E

Green

- Cut 16 2 x 16 1/2" strips
- Cut 21 1 1/2" strips WOF, sew these together to make:
 - 2 1 1/2 x 109" Top/Bottom Border #3 strips
 - 2 1 1/2 x 107 1/2" Side Border #3 strips
 - 2 1 1/2 x 101 1/2" Top/Bottom Border #1 strips
 - 2 1 1/2 x 99 1/2" Side Border #1 strips

King Quilt Assembly

- Follow the same instructions for Red and Purple flowers as the Full quilt, making 2 of each
- Sew 1 Red and 1 Purple Flower together with 1 2 x 34" White strip between them, creating 2 sets
- Sew the 2 Flower rows together with 1 2 x 69" White strip between them and alternating the flower colors
- Sew 1 1 1/2 x 68 1/2" White strip to each side of flowers
- Sew 1 1 1/2 x 71 1/2" White strip to the top and bottom of the flowers
- Mark the center of the White strips
- Sew 2 White triangles together along the 36" side (Fig B). Repeat with remaining triangles to create 4 new triangles
 - Match the center seam of the triangle with the center of the flower rows and sew the triangles to the quilt
- Trim outside edge as needed to create a 99 x 99" square
- Add Green Border #1, then White Border #2, and finish with Green Border #3
- · Add back, quilt and bind
